Medications for prostate enlargement or BPH have side effects and often are responsible for developing new health problems. Medical intervention in men with enlarged prostate uses 2 types of medications.

Firstly, alpha blockers, which relax the muscle of the prostate and bladder neck that allows urine to flow more easily, Tamsulosin, terazosin, etc. These drugs can be responsible for **tiredness, sexual dysfunction, headache and dizziness.**

Secondly, hormonal drugs - 5 alpha reductase inhibitors: finasteride, Avodart responsible for irreversible side effects: impotence, depression, testicle pain, and even diabetes.

Therefore, all medications to treat prostate enlargement

should be prescribed carefully and as a short-term treatment. Furthermore, the daily use of these dangerous drugs is very expensive.

BPH surgeries differ, some of them remove and another destroy the prostate tissue. All these procedures have nasty complications. Therefore, about 25% of patients after minimal invasive surgery suffer from depression. Therefore, any operation must be accepted only as a treatment of last resort.
